Nearest Hospital with A&E Department Addenbrooke's Hospital Hills Road Cambridge CB2 0QQ

Head East (towards Cambridge) on the A14. Follow the signs for M11 South. Turn off the M11 at junction 11 (Cambridge South).

Turn left at the roundabout on to Hauxton Road. Turn right at the traffic lights towards the hospital. Proceed straight on at the next set of traffic lights.

Turn right at the roundabout. Proceed straight on at the second roundabout. Turn left at the next roundabout. Take the next right.

At the end of the road proceed straight on, and follow the road. Turn right at the roundabout.

A&E can be found on the left hand side.



Bar Hill Cricket Club Incident/Accident Procedure



In the event of an incident/accident:

Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation.

Is there a risk of further injury? Do not put yourself in danger.

Listen to what the injured person is saying.

Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries. First Aid kits are in the Club shed.

In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – 999.

Do not move someone with major injuries - wait for the emergency medics.

Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.

Contact the parent / carer / guardian of an injured Junior.

Complete an Incident / Accident Report Form (in the Captain's Pack) and give it to the Club Welfare Officer (Julia Thompson).

Details of the local Doctors surgery / hospital can be found overleaf.

In the event of an incident / accident occurring through insufficient training or faulty equipment / facilities, the follow up action taken should include the completion of a Risk Assessment.
